Elizabeth Morgan has been the Environmental Educator for the City of Rock Hill since 2005. In her position, Ms. Morgan coordinates and manages environmental outreach, education programs and special events to promote litter reduction, recycling, water quality initiatives, and air quality awareness. She is the staff liaison to the Rock Hill Clean & Green Board, a Keep America Beautiful Affiliate and has written and managed numerous federal and state grants from various entities. During her career, Ms. Morgan has assisted the City in receiving numerous awards, and was recognized in 2011 by the Carolina Recycling Association as the Recycler of the Year for North and South Carolina. Ms. Morgan has a degree in Environmental Studies from the University of Kansas, a Master's in Business Administration from Winthrop University, and a Post Graduate Diploma in Corporate Sustainability from Furman University.

Robert Harris is the Street/Sanitation Superintendent for the Town of Fort Mill. He has been employed by the town for 15 years.

Cedric Alexander is the Sanitation Supervisor for the Town of Fort Mill. Before taking this position, Cedric worked for the City of Lancaster for approximately 8 years.
