



Anne Springs Close Greenway Archers Program

The **Anne Springs Close Greenway Archers Program** is managed by the Greenway's Natural Resources staff who work directly with South Carolina Department of Natural Resources (SCDNR) to effectively control wildlife overpopulation and prevent disease. A designated group of experienced bow hunters are assigned specific hunting zones within the Anne Springs Close Greenway, who are then evaluated annually and granted access based on set criteria. Archers are prohibited from hunting within 50 feet of Greenway property line or 50 yards of a trail. Archers are required to register with the Greenway Resource Director before each entry and all parties must report time of departure upon leaving. Archers are required to be 15 feet above ground, aiming in a downward angle and wear a safety harness while in the tree stand. Harvesting is allowed on weekdays and in selected zones on weekends. Archers should park in designated areas and no member may hunt a different area unit without prior planning. Greenway Archer ID tag must be placed on all stands at eye level for identification. Hunting will be by archery only. No firearms are allowed on Greenway property. Deer season is August 31st – December 31st. Any other parties hunting on Greenway property will be considered poaching and appropriate legal action will be taken for trespassing.
