Leaders in Training

Rising 9th-Rising 12th Grades

Campers must be 14 years before the first day of training.

Our Leaders-In-Training (LIT) program is designed for those who are ready to begin the transition from camper to counselor by using their camp experience to help create positive experiences for younger campers. Rising 9th through rising 12th grade students are eligible to apply (applicants must be 14 before the first day of training). The LIT program begins with mandatory training, where LITs will learn leadership skills, such as public speaking, time management, goal setting, problem solving, and more. They will also learn the expectations of their role during volunteer weeks. After training, LITs are required to volunteer a minimum of two weeks at summer camp where they will assist their counselors in leading groups of campers while also participating in camp activities. LITs must be responsible with strong leadership abilities.

To apply, applicants must submit an application questionnaire and two letters of recommendation from non-family members with their EZChildTrack application. Returning LITs may omit the letters of recommendation. The link to these documents can be found on our website at ASCGreenway.org/camps. **Applicants will need to upload these documents during the application process so they must be completed before applying.**

Cost: \$155; \$100 non-refundable deposit due at registration. *Greenway Family Membership holders receive 10% off balance of camp.*
