The creative behind **Carl Peacock**

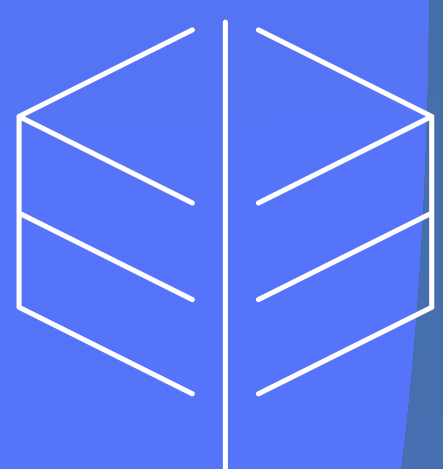
The Peacock is a symbol of magnificence and wisdom, and this sculpture was thoughtfully crafted to reflect the beauty and grace these remarkable creatures embody. Every detail has been carefully hand-bent and forged from metal dowels, while the tree on which the peacock perches is sculpted and hand-forged from metal pipes, showcasing exceptional artistry. The intricate tail, composed of over 800 individually hand-bent metal strands, wraps elegantly around the tree, giving the sculpture a commanding and refined presence. To achieve a finish befitting such a regal creature, this sculpture is finished in automotive paint, featuring multiple layers of shimmer and a dynamic, a color-changing effect on the tail, and vividly capturing the dazzling hues of a peacock's plumage. This extraordinary piece is named in honor of Huelani's mentor and studio partner, paying tribute to their guidance and influence.
